'THERE'S MORE TO SAY AFTER R U OK?'

Yesterday was R U OK?Day, a day which promotes mental health awareness and advocates for us to have conversations with others who might be having a tough time, and help them to find support.

Even though R U OK?Day has passed, we can still keep the conversation going. If you have a feeling that someone you know or care about it isn't behaving as they normally would. Perhaps they seem out of sorts? More agitated or withdrawn? Or they're just not themselves. Trust that gut instinct and act on it.

By starting a conversation and commenting on the changes you've noticed, you could help that family member, friend or workmate open up. If they say they are not ok, you can follow the conversation steps below to show them they're supported and help them find strategies to better manage. If they are ok, that person will know you're someone who cares enough to ask (ruok.org.au).

If you're unsure how to start the conversation, here are some simple steps:



1. Ask



2. Listen



3. Encourage action



4. Check in
