Our school will be participating in this day as it is a great way to inspire our students to develop an understanding of the impact of rubbish on our environment and ways in which they can actively help reduce rubbish. During the day we will engage in a whole school clean up. During this time students will be provided with bags, buckets, tongs and gloves so they are picking up rubbish safely. We will also be telling students not to pick up any sharp objects/rubbish such as glass. Students will be instructed that if they find any rubbish like this that they must tell a teacher rather than picking it up themselves. During the day we will take photos and we look forward to sharing these with you.

Thank you to all the families who have ensured that they have connected to either SeeSaw or Class Dojo depending on which platform your child's class is using. If you have not yet connected could you please connect as soon as possible.
