#### Yr 6/7s to High School News

## Maze Challenge


Each of our Year 6/7 classes were given the challenge of creating their own maze, with the intention of it being given to the partnering class to complete.


After a lot of measuring, designing and problem solving students were ready to engage in a bit of friendly competition.


