Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Canteen news

As many of you know, from March 1st some restrictions have been introduced around the use of single use plastics. The current restrictions no longer allow for the use of plastic straws, spoons or forks. This will impact on our school canteen. Julie has been working very hard to find non-plastic forks, spoons and straws but it does come with an increased cost. Rather than increasing canteen prices, Julie will only be handing out these items if they are required for a lunch order. This means that if your child has lunch from home that needs some cutlery, this cutlery will need to be supplied from home. We will keep you updated on the ongoing changes in the use of single-use plastics. At this stage, none of it will result in changes to the canteen menu but this may have to occur at a later date depending on the next wave of restrictions.

In order to maintain social distancing we ask that you only attend those assemblies that are being run by your child's class or where your child is performing or receiving an award.
