## Just Keep Swimming, Savannah!

On September 27th & 28th Savannah from room 17 competed in the 13&Under State Short Course Swimming Championships held at the SA Aquatic Centre in Marion. She had qualified in 5 events in the 10/11 age group. 50m & 100m backstrokes, 50m butterfly & the 50m & 100m freestyle events. She swam personal best times in all events & was in the top 10 for the 10 year olds in all events, her favourite being the 100m backstroke in which she was the 2nd fastest 10-year-old! Savannah trains 5 times a week with the Clovercrest Swimming Club. Savannah has been selected in the Para Districts SAPSASA Swimming team to compete at the Marion pool on Wednesday Nov 18th. She will swim in 4 events 50m freestyle, backstroke & butterfly & a freestyle relay. GO SAVANNAH!

### Term 4 Swimming Update

After having our school swimming pool inspected, we have discovered that there are some issues that need to be fixed and that until they are fixed we are unable to use the pool due to safety issues. We investigated the possibility of fixing the pool this term but it would be unsafe and intrusive to do any of the work with students around. We are endeavouring to have the problem fixed as soon as we can in the safest way possible.

This means that we will be unable to run any swimming lessons this term. We realise this is very disappointing news but we need to ensure the safety and wellbeing of our community, particularly our students, comes first. ## What is Saver Plus?

- A free ten-month savings program providing financial education, budgeting and savings tips.
- Participants receive up to \$500 from ANZ in matched savings for education costs for themselves or their children.
- Delivered by Brotherhood of St Laurence, Berry Street, The Benevolent Society and The Smith Family and other local community organisations.
- Offered in communities across Australia in every state and territory.

### A Saver Plus Participant's Journey

- Goal**  
Talks to a Saver Plus Coordinator from a community organisation and, if eligible for the program, sets a goal to save a regular amount of money over 10 months
- Saving**  
Opens an ANZ Progress Saver account and makes regular deposits
- Education**  
Completes the MoneyMinded financial education program with support from a Saver Plus Coordinator
- Matching**  
Reaches savings goal and receives matched funds, up to \$500, for their own or their children's education costs

### Benefits for participants<sup>1</sup>

- 87% continue to save the same amount or more 3 to 7 years after completing the program
- 78% were better equipped for unexpected expenses
- 88% reported increased self-esteem
- 80% had more control over their finances

### Who can join?

Participants must meet all of the below criteria:

- Be 18 years or over
- Have a child at school or starting next year, or attend vocational education themselves
- Have regular income from paid employment (themselves or their partner)
- Have a current Health Care or Pensioner Concession Card
- Be in receipt of an eligible Commonwealth social security benefit, allowance or payment\*

### How did it start?

Saver Plus began in 2003 as a Brotherhood of St Laurence and ANZ pilot program with 268 participants in three sites across Victoria and New South Wales.

Since then, the program has expanded to all Australian states and territories, reaching more than 40,000 people, making it the largest and longest-running program of its kind in the world.
